

Energy Supply

Proposed Appropriation Language

For expenses of the Department of Energy activities including the purchase, construction and acquisition of plant and capital equipment and other expenses necessary for energy supply, and uranium supply and enrichment activities in carrying out the purposes of the Department of Energy Organization Act (42 U.S.C. 7101 et seq.), including the acquisition or condemnation of any real property or any facility or for plant or facility acquisition, construction, or expansion; and the purchase of not to exceed [22] 1 passenger motor [vehicles] *vehicle* for replacement only[, \$727,091,000, of which not to exceed \$3,000 may be used for official reception and representation expenses for transparency activities], \$841,888,000 to remain available until September 30, 2001, of which \$820,953 shall be derived by transfer from the Geothermal Resources Development Fund, and of which \$5,000,000 shall be derived by transfer from the United States Enrichment Corporation Fund. (*Energy and Water Development Appropriation Act, 1999.*)

[*SEC 108.* An additional amount of \$60,000,000 for Department of Energy—Energy Programs, “Energy Supply”, is hereby appropriated to remain available until September 30, 2000.] (*Omnibus Consolidated and Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act, 1999, Public Law 105-277, Division A, Section 108.*)

Explanation of Change

- Language provides that funding will remain available for 2 years.
- All remaining unobligated balances are transferred from the Geothermal Resources Development Fund and the account will be closed.
- \$5 million is transferred from the United States Enrichment Corporation Fund for the disposition of depleted uranium hexafluoride inventory as authorized by P.L. 105-204.
